A20 Junction Improvement, Dover

Overnight closures of York Street are planned for the nights of 17 & 18 November and the 5 nights of 21-25 November 2016 inclusive.

Closures are from 21:00 hours through to 05:00 hours each night, with the road otherwise re-opened.

York Street Diversions -

- The northbound and southbound carriageways of York Street will both be closed at same time.
- The northbound carriageway closure is from York Street junction to the traffic light junction with Queen Street.
- The alternative route is westbound on A20 Snargate Street / Limekiln Street / Archcliffe Road / A20 Trunk Road to Court Wood Interchange then eastbound on B2011 Folkestone Road.
- The southbound carriageway closure is between the junction with Worthington Street and York Street junction.
- The alternative route is via A256 Priory Road / High Street / London Road / Crabble Hill / London Road / Whitfield Hill and Whitfield Roundabout, then as signposted on site to Docks.
- New Street will be closed at the junction with York Street, and can be accessed via Queen's Gardens

M20/A20 Eastbound Diversion - Traffic wishing to access the port -

- A20 Trunk Road to Court Wood Interchange then eastbound on B2011 Folkestone Road.
- Then via A256 Priory Road / High Street / London Road / Crabble Hill / London Road / Whitfield Hill and Whitfield Roundabout, then as signposted on site to Docks.

Westbound Traffic from the port –

- The A20 trunk road westbound will remain open.
