Notice to Mariners 17/17

Instalation of the Dover Western Docks Exclusion Zone

An exclusion zone will be put in place with works beginning on the 25th March 2017, and will then remain in place, for the duration of the marine civils work being undertaken as part of the Dover Western Docks Redevelopment. The zone will provide a marked delineation between the Leisure Zone and the Marine Constructions works area to the east of the Prince of Wales Pier. **See figure 1.**

During the Dover Western Docks Revival project mariners should expect to see a significant increase in vessel traffic movements in and around the Western docks. Mariners are therefore advised to navigate with caution at all times and to take directions from Dover Port Control (VTS).

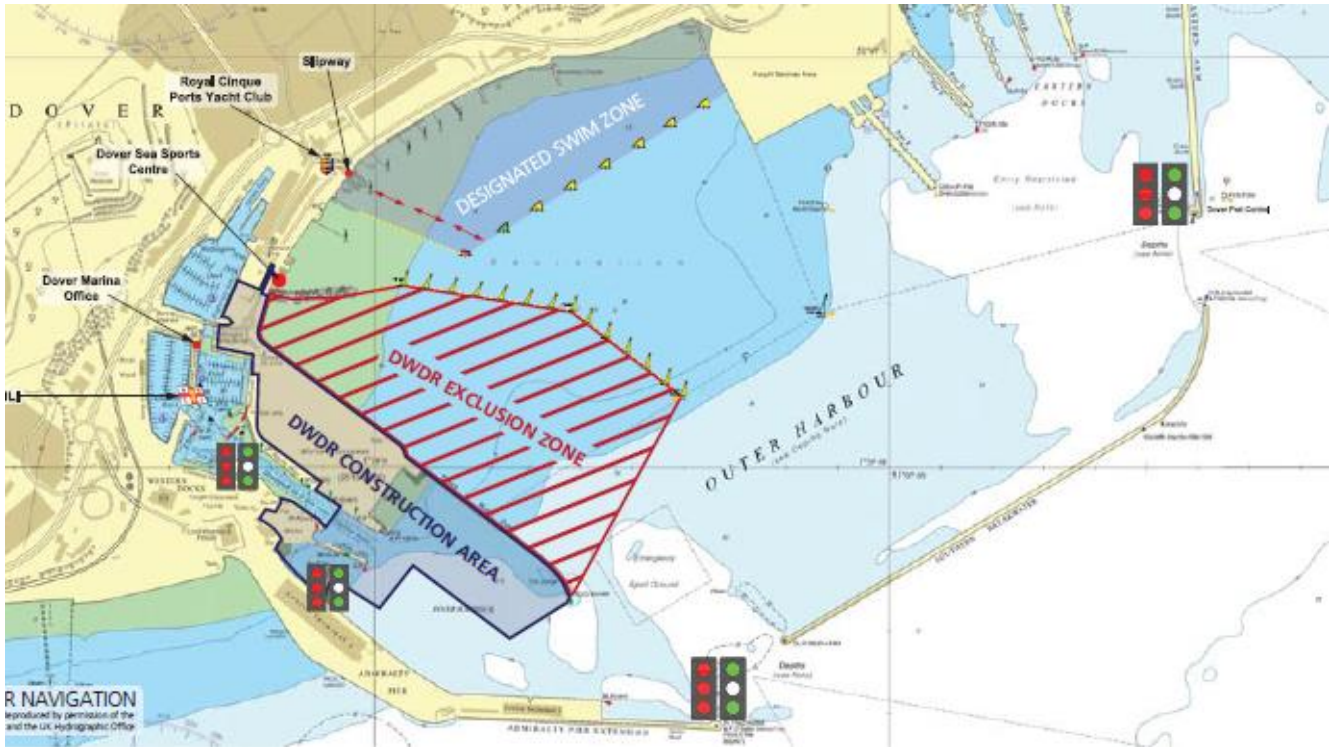
Mariners are advised that various work activities will take place within the DWDR exclusion zone, including but not limited to dredging, diving and piling. Any such work activity within the zone is covered by the contents of this Local Notice to Mariners and will not be subject to any further notice.

The DWDR exclusion zone is bounded by the Prince of Wales Pier to the West, the shoreline to the North and the following coordinates to the East: -

Position 'C'	51°07.215'N	001°18.945'E
Position 'D'	51°07.220'N	001°19.050'E
Position 'E'	51°07.185'N	001°19.370'E
Position 'F'	51°07.085'N	001°19.590'E
Position 'G'	51°06.840'N	001°19.380'E

The DWDR exclusion zone may only be entered by authorised vessels, all non authorised vessels are to remain outside and clear of the marked exclusion zone.
