Local Notice to Mariners 21/17

Dredging & Scour Removal/Pile Cutting – Old Hoverport & Approaches

Mariners are advised that dredging and scour removal/pile cutting works will be taking place in the vicinity of the old Hoverport berth and approaches in the Western Docks, this work will be taking place 24 hrs a day, 7 days a week.

Works will commence on the 3rd April 2017 and continue until further notice, the works will be undertaken by the following vessels:

MP40	Backhoe dredger
Wadden 1	Split hopper barge
Wadden 4	Split hopper barge
Sospan Dau	Trailer Suction Hopper Dredger
Strandway	Trailer Suction Hopper Dredger
Morag M	Multicat/plough

Vessels navigating within the area of these works should keep well clear of the above vessels and associated works at all times. Vessels should in addition take directions from Dover Port Control on VHF Ch.74.

Safety vessel "CRC Hercules" will be in attendance throughout the works.
