Dredging Operation in the Wick Channel

Mariners are advised that the dredger "Sospan Dau" will carry out dredging operations in the Wick Channel and its approaches from 19:00hrs 19th May to 08:00 20th May 2017.



Vessels navigating within the area of these works should keep well clear of the "Sospan Dau" at all times. Vessels should in addition take directions from Dover Port Control on VHF Ch.74.

The ports Harbour Patrol launch will be available throughout the duration of works and will assist Port Control in controlling the movement of vessels in this area.
