Diving Operations on Dunkirk Jetty

Mariners are advised that diving operations are to take place on the Dunkirk Jetty in Dover Western Docks, commencing immediately and continuing until further notice, including overnight. Diving will be carried out from and supervised from the deck of the adjacent Barge.

Mariners are requested to pass well clear at reduced speed and be guided by Dover Port Control on VHF Ch.74. This particularly applies to vessels using the adjacent North & South channel to/from the Tidal Harbour Basin.
