Local Notice to Mariners 43/17

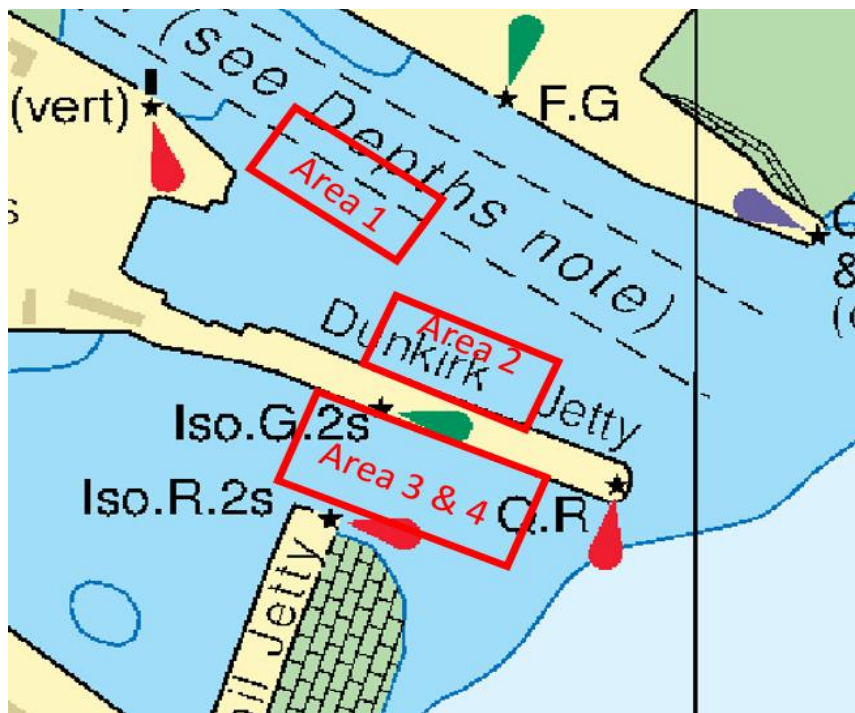
Diving Operations in the Wick Channel and Dunkirk Jetty Area

Mariners are advised that Diving Operations will be carried out by Sealift Diving LTD. Diving will take place in the Wick Channel and Dunkirk Jetty area.

Diving will take place on Friday 7th July 08:00 to 17:00 in areas 3 and 4 and Sunday 9th July 19:00- 06:00 in areas 1 and 2 as indicated on the chart below.

Diving support vessel Sealift III will be in attendance throughout the operation. Vessels are requested to pass clear and at a slow speed taking directions from Dover Port Control on VHF74.
