
Local Notice to Mariners 44/17

Dredging Operations in the Wick Channel and Dunkirk Jetty Area

Mariners are advised that Dredging Operations will be carried out by the Backhoe Dredger "Kreeft" and the spoil will be removed by the split hopper barges "Wadden 1" and "Wadden 2". Dredging will take place in the Wick Channel and Dunkirk Jetty areas.

Dredging will take place from Sunday 9th July 08:00 to Monday 17th July 19:00 and will be concentrated on areas marked on the chart below, Areas 1,2,3 and 4.

Vessels are requested to pass clear and at a slow speed taking directions from Dover Port Control on VHF74 at all times.
